Always a pioneer and in harmony with his time, Pierre Kunz adopts contemporary trends while preserving a classic essence.

He has now launched a 44 mm diameter tourbillon, available in grey gold, red gold or platinum, with reversing retrograde hands.

A breathtaking retrograde triple second: the hands only move every 60 seconds. A sophisticated mechanism which brings a touch of added complication to an already complicated model.

The dial features Roman numeral applied chapters, a top frame bridge proudly sporting the initials PK at 6 o'clock and integral retrograde zone, reinterpreting the ace of spades.

Pierre Kunz gives us a new style of mobility – another reminder that he is still the master of retrograde time display!

Movement: Mechanical with open case back, calibre PK 2103-2393, ø34.4mm, high 7.7mm, 36 rubies, 18000 A/h.

Functions: Tourbillon, Triple retrograde second.

Hands: blued steel

Dial: black and white. With Roman numerals appliques. Retrograde zone guilloché.

Case: fluted Empire-style case in grey gold, red gold 5N and platinum, 44 mm diameter, high 12.5mm, sapphire glass.

Strap: chocolate, cognac and black hand-stitched alligator skin.

Power reserve 70 hours.

Water resistant to 30 meters.
